Seeds



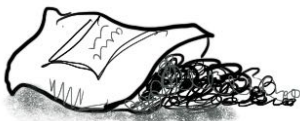
Seeds come in all shapes and sizes.

Container



Use cups, pots or even an egg crate.

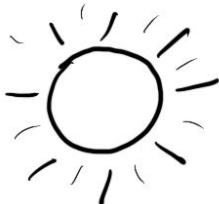
Potting soil



Water

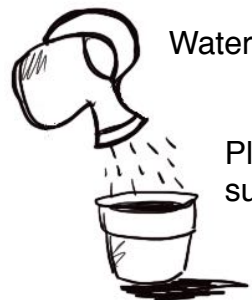


Sun



LET'S PLANT:

Add soil to your pot. Mix soil with a little water. Add seeds. Cover your seeds with a bit more soil.



Water

Place by a sunny window.



CARE: Water when the soils is dry. Rotate the pots. Watch them grow. (Label your pots so you know what you planted!)



When the weather is warmer (usually May-June) and the seedlings are bigger and sprouting more leaves, plant them in your garden.
